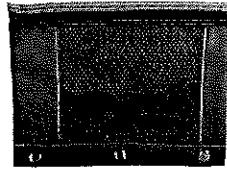



Mrs. McFadden's Student Supply List (Preschool 3)

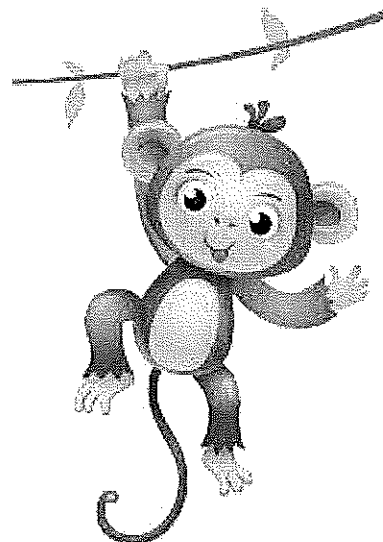

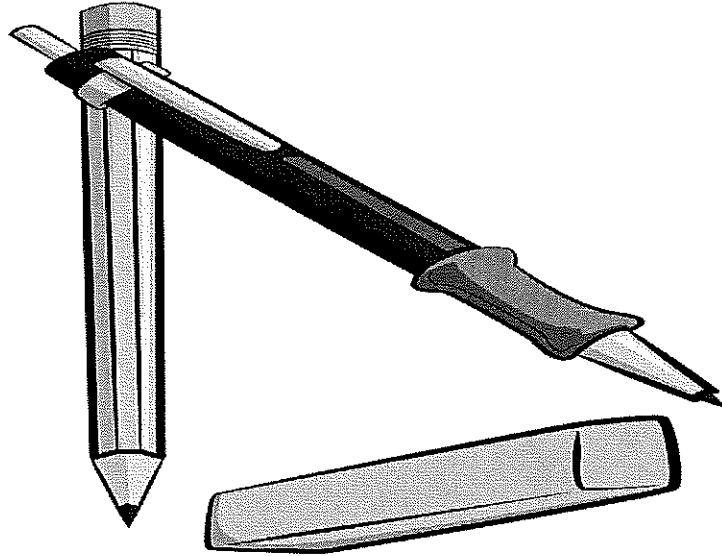
